On my passport into heaven.



He brought a great message which ended with him relating two stories of projects FAME has been a part of, one of which New Life has had a major role. Last year we collected about \$20,000.00 to help construct a medical clinic in Sandia, Mexico, a community where medical help is a two-hour drive. After



many delays due to corona virus issues construction finally began at the end of last year. Bill brought pictures that he received about Christmas time last year showing the progress. The foundation is in and the walls are beginning to go up. It is a great feeling to know that our participation with FAME in this project will provide medical care for people who are hours away from doctors. The project managers have promised to send pictures as progress is made. When we receive them, we will share them with you.

One more FAME related story. Our own Fred and Molly Plantz collect used medical equipment, crutches, walkers, etc. and take them to FAME's headquarters in Indianapolis, IN. I received a text from them this week saying their trailer was full and they are planning a trip to FAME soon. Soon this equipment will be distributed to various parts of the world.
